Thérèse Larsdotter Damm has been working as Senior Study Coordinator and team leader at A+ Science City Site for almost a year now.

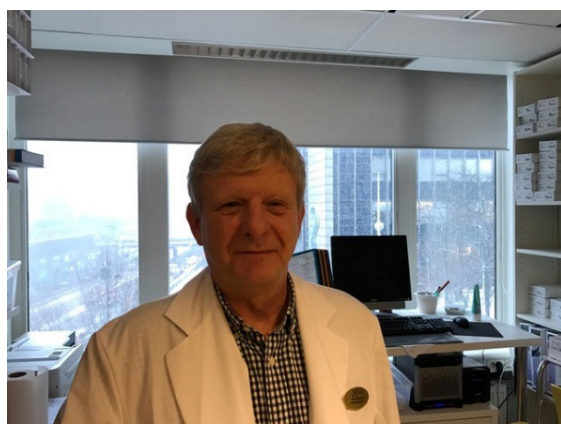
